**NZ Masters Acceptance of Entry
Terms and Conditions**

1. PLAYING RULES

1.1 ORDER OF PLAY

- 1.2 The order of throw shall be decided by the toss of a coin.
1.3 The winner of the toss shall throw first for the bull in the first leg. The winner of the throw (i.e. the closest to the bull) shall lead off in the first and alternative legs. The opponent shall lead off in the even numbered legs. If legs are even and a deciding leg has to be played (i.e. 1 each in best of 3 leg match, 2 each in best of 5 etc.) a fresh toss shall be made and both players shall throw for the bull again for the right to lead off.

2. GENERAL RULES

- 2.1 All players participating must play under their own names
2.2 **23.16 CONDUCT** During a match - players shall conduct themselves in a manner of respect for the other player (s) and shall refrain from annoying the other player (s) or using offensive language or making offensive gestures and shall refrain from any unsportsmanlike conduct (I.E. such as deliberately losing a Leg or match, deliberately delaying match play, or interfering with the throw of another player.)
2.3 Any player found by the Organisers to be in breach of Clause 23.16 shall be deemed to have brought the Sport of Darts into disrepute and shall be disqualified from any further participation in the tournament.
2.4 The Council appointed organisers reserve the right to protect their sponsor's interests with regard to any advertising material, slogans, or logos used by players, teams or other sponsors during a Council event.
2.5 Players and spectators in a council darts event will not be allowed to wear any clothing that bears any advertising material, slogans, or logos relating to any marketable product or concern without the prior permission of the Council appointed organisers.

3. ELIGIBILITY

WDF Playing & Tournament Rules

- 3.1.1 9.02 A WDF Member Darts Body or its appointed organisers shall reserve the right to refuse, or cancel any entrant, at any stage prior to, during, or after a darts event which is within their jurisdiction and their decision shall be final in all matches relating to that darts event. (Bylaw No 32)
3.1.2 Any Matter not expressly covered above shall be determined in ACCORDANCE with the WDF Playing and Tournament Rules.
