WDF PLAYERS COMMISSION

The purpose of the WDF Players Commission is to provide a channel of communication whereby internationally active players will have a formal role in decision-making processes within the WDF.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COMMISSION

The responsibilities of the WDF Players' Commission are:

Offer assistance and advice to the WDF Executive on matters which are relevant to players within the structure of the WDF.

Present the point of view of the players to the WDF Executive on anti-doping issues and matters concerning the health of players.

Submit reports and recommendations to the WDF Executive on matters of relevance to players.

OPERATION

The Players Commission shall consist of a maximum of five members.

The Chairperson shall be chosen by the elected members themselves.

There must be at least two male and one female internationally active players elected at each election.

Only players who have broad international experience are eligible for election.

The period of office for members of the Players Commission shall be two years and elections shall be held in conjunction with the WDF World Cup.

The Commission shall be responsible for setting up each meeting and for inviting players to attend.

The Players Commission shall hold at least one formal meeting each year. This may be done online if required.

One member of the Players Commission shall be entitled to attend WDF Executive meetings as an official non-voting observer.
