## **WDF YOUTH IN SPORT COMMISSION**

The purpose of the WDF Youth in Sport Commission is to provide a channel of communication whereby experts on topics like Youth, Darts as School and University sport and Youth Development issues will be brought in on a formal basis to the decision-making processes within the WDF.

## **RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COMMISSION**

The responsibilities of the WDF Youth in Sport Commission are:

To offer assistance and advice to the WDF Executive on matters which are relevant to the youth and promotion of youth participation within the structure of the WDF.

To offer proposals on the development and implementation of a WDF youth in sport strategy.

To submit reports and recommendations to the WDF Executive on matters of relevance to the youth and promotion of youth creating a youthful image of the sport.

## **OPERATION**

The Youth in Sport Commission shall consist of a maximum of five members.

The Youth Commissioner (Chairperson) is elected by the WDF General Meeting in the odd numbered years,

The members are elected by a youth managers' meeting in the odd numbered years.

The composition of the Commission shall be representing the principles of continental diversity and gender equality.

The period of office for members of the Youth in Sport Commission shall be two years.

The Commission shall be responsible for setting up each meeting and for inviting members to attend.

The Youth in Sport Commission shall hold at least one formal meeting each year. This may be done on-line if required.
